TRANSMITTAL OF LICENSE EXTENSION - 210017DN

Dear Ms. Bowman:

This letter transmits an extension of the license issued by the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) to operate an alcoholism or drug abuse recovery or treatment facility, The Helen Vine Recovery Center, located at 291 Smith Ranch Road, San Rafael, California 94903. The enclosed license will remain in effect from April 1, 2023 through March 31, 2025, in the absence of any administrative action taken by the Department.

The Department's approval of the application for extension of licensure does not prohibit the Department from taking action to suspend or revoke licensure pursuant to Health and Safety Code, Division 10.5, Part 2, Chapter 7.5; California Code of Regulations, Title 9, section 10548.

It is the responsibility of the provider to notify DHCS of any cessation of services, sale or transfer of ownership affecting the provider or the facility, change of administration, change of location of the facility or change of mailing address.

In accordance with the California Code of Regulations, (CCR) Title 9, Section 10529 (a)(2)(A)(B), the program shall submit the Request for License and/or Certification Extension DHCS Form 5999 (6/15) with all supporting documentation and renewal fees to the department prior to the expiration date of the license. Failure to provide all necessary documentation shall result in the termination of the license in accordance with CCR Title 9, Section10539 (c).
